


GOOD

Removable, Plastic Snaps: ~~6-8k~~ \$4-5k



Includes 2 implants on bottom, anchoring existing denture

Full replacement with 4 implants on top: ~~21-23k~~ \$15-17k


Full replacement with 2 implants on bottom: ~~13-14k~~ \$10-11k

Pros: Triples chewing capacity compared to regular dentures.
Removable palate. Cleansable. Least costly.

Cons: Replace plastic fittings 1x/yr. Less stability.
Remove teeth at night.

BETTER

Permanent, Fixed Hybrid "All on 4": ~~23-28k~~ \$16-18k



Includes 4-6 implants

When transitioning from natural teeth: ~~30-35k~~ \$23-25k

Pros: Best chewing capacity. Most stability. Do not remove
teeth at night. Removable palate.

Cons: High maintenance. More office visits. Not cleansable.
Prone to infection. Most costly.

BEST

Removable, Metal Snaps "Conus": ~~20-25k~~ \$14-16k



Includes 4-6 implants

When transitioning from natural teeth: ~~29-32k~~ \$20-23k

Pros: Excellent chewing capacity and stability. Least
maintenance. Cleansable. Removable palate. Less
costly.

Cons: Remove teeth at night
